ISNO President's Annual AWARD for 'Best Clinician Researcher' in Neuro-Oncology

This award will be given to a person with a post-graduate medical degree who has done excellent research in basic and/or molecular neuro-oncology

Eligibility criteria

The nominee

- i) should have a *post graduate master's degree* in any *clinical fields* related to neuro-oncology practice (*MCh/DNB in Neurosurgery; DM/DNB in Neurology; MD/DNB in Radiation Oncology; or DM/DNB in Medical or Pediatric Oncology*). It is expected that the nominee is *currently active in some form of clinical work* (clinics, wards etc) either full-time or at least part time.
- ii) The nominee should be of *Indian origin* and done the *entire/majority of the work* in an *Institute/Medical College/University within India*.
- iii) The nominee should not have completed *50 years* as on *January 1st, 2024*.
- iv) The award would be given to a *specific basic and/or molecular biology work* done in *India* and may have been *published within last two years* in a reputed journal. The nominee should be either a *lead researcher* or have played a *significant part within the collaborative group* for the submitted work.
- v) The nominee should be an *ISNO member* at the time of submission.
- vi) The applicant should be nominated by an ISNO member and *self-nominations will not be accepted*.
- vii) A *relevant published paper* related to the applicant's research work and published in the *last two calendar years (2022-2023)* if any, is highly recommended. A pdf of the publication or a copy of the manuscript in case it is accepted and in press (with proof of acceptance from the journal) along with a *no-objection certificate from all the authors* of the published manuscript should be submitted along with the application.
- vi) The award carries a *cash prize* and a *citation*.
- vii) The awardee will be given an opportunity to make an *oral presentation* in the *Awards Session* during the *Annual Meeting (ISNOCON 2024)* at *Chandigarh*.

Nomination procedure: Please send the application on a piece of paper detailing the scientific contributions including the reprint of the published paper, if any, to be considered for the award. A CV of the applicant along with a formal nomination by an ISNO member (with name, signature, date, affiliation, address and ISNO Membership number) must accompany the submission. A soft copy (scanned PDF version as e-mail attachments) of the submission also needs to be included along with application. Incomplete submissions will be liable to be not considered for the award.
